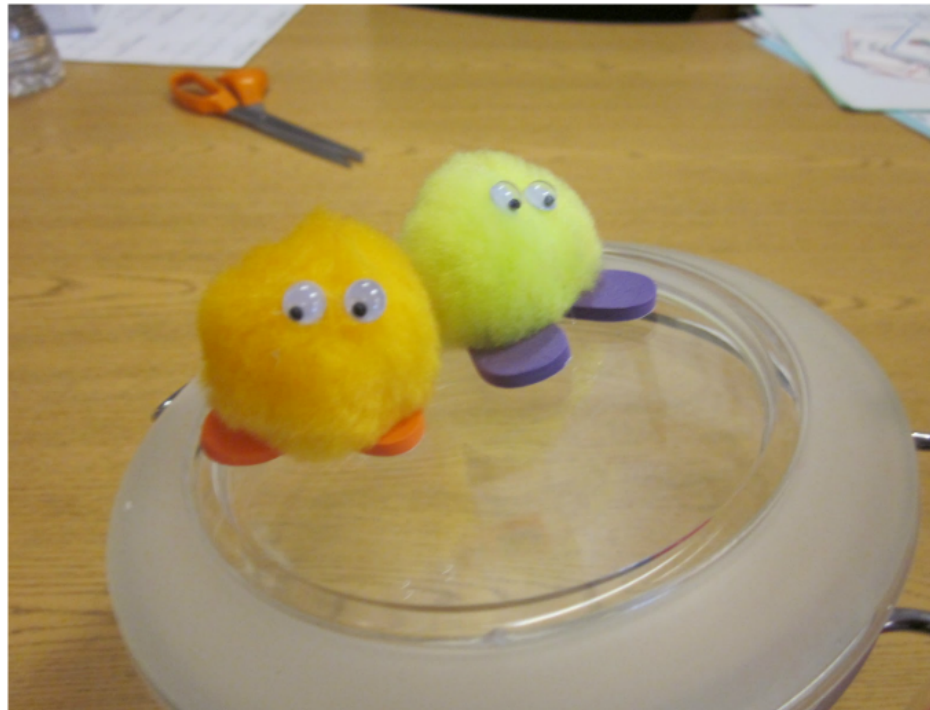
# What does this mean?

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In individual poverty, there are no attitudes, beliefs, or values that are passed on to the next generation. The only reason a child lives in poverty is the way that parent(s) live.

In Generational Poverty: There is a prevailing attitude that society sees the individual. Generational poverty has its own culture, hidden rules, attitudes, and belief system.

Types of Poverty

Individual Poverty: This is a person who has been in poverty for two generations.

Generational Poverty: This is a lack of resources due to a major event. This could be illness, divorce, death, etc.
