Deficiencies in monitoring and evaluation practices A relatively major weakness is the lack of adequate monitoring and evaluation for assessing progress made by the program.

Lacking such a system makes it challenging to find out areas of growth deficit or the way child development will be affected in the future, if it is affected at all.
