Introduction

Burma also known as Myanmar has been struggling for democratic transition from early 2000s. That political transition process although full of hope and ambivalence was considered a positive shift in the country. This case focuses on Myanmar's socio-political environment, its opportunities, and threats as well as the position of foreign actors.
