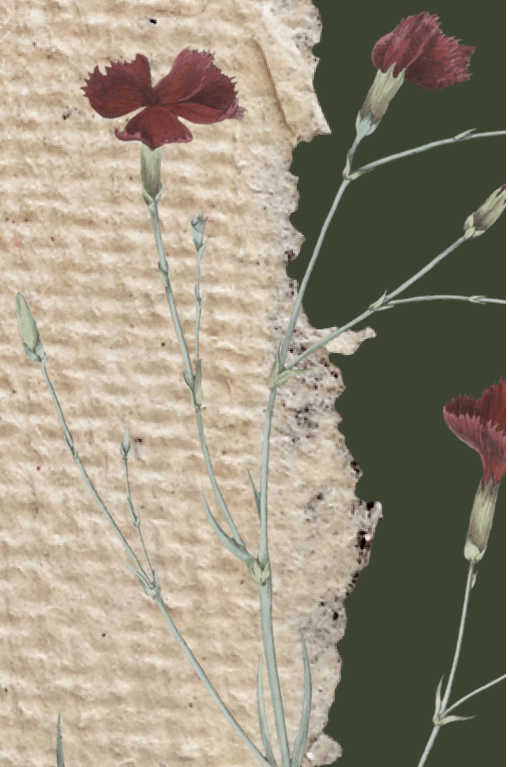
# Introduction

# Key Challenges

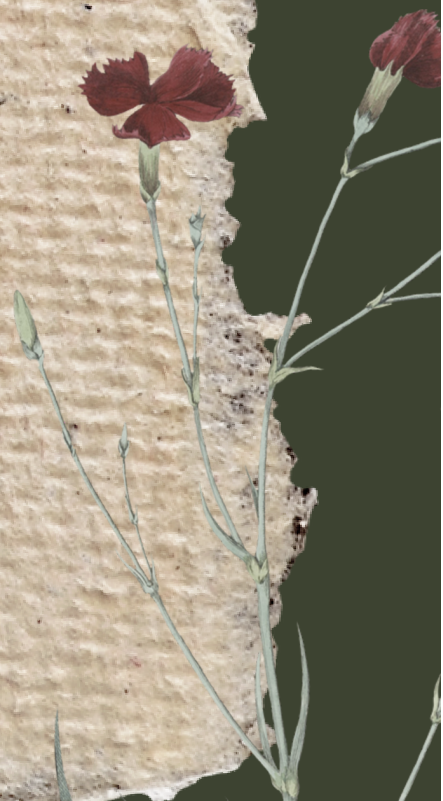
